# Important Must Know Guidelines

#### Timeline for the event:

Deadline for Receiving Entries: November 1, 2023

Competition Results are posted: January, 2024

## **Eligibility:**

The competition is open to Assyrian artists from around the world aged 18 years or older.

#### ARTWORK CRITERIA

- Two-dimensional artwork
- Painting (oil, acrylic, watercolor)
- Drawings (colored pencil, ink, marker, pastel, charcoal, graphite)
- Collages (must be two-dimensional)
- Mixed Media (Use of more than two mediums listed above)
- Artwork entered must be in the original medium (that is, not a scanned reproduction of a painting or drawing).
- Must be a minimum of 5 sq/ft (24"x30") or 152.4 sq/cm in size

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Include a brief (200 word maximum) "Artist Statement" explaining your art, your creative process and what the theme means to you.

We require a digital picture of your art along with your completed application form.

Prepare your images as required before beginning the submission process.

# Digital image files must meet the following specifications:

- A. JPEG files only. Please remember that photos must not be digitally enhanced or altered.
- B. Please send three high-resolution pictures (1080 x 1080 pixels) picture from your smart phone works fine.
- C. Do not send images of your artwork which have been framed or contain watermarks.
- D. Assyrian Cultural Foundation may color correct your images in order to enhance the overall presentation, and may crop your images for formatting purposes for use in their slideshow presentations, other off-site slideshows, YouTube presentations, other Contemporary Art Gallery Online presentations; and for other areas of its website if your images are chosen.
- E. Complete the entire application form and load all images before sending the email.

#### **RULES**

• Entry must be original in concept, design and execution, and may not violate U.S. copyright laws. Non-compliance to this rule will be a disqualification of your entry.

- Participants are allowed submit one (1) piece.
- Participants should submit their a new work of art made for the competition.
- Submissions after deadlines will not be considered for evaluation.
- Participants will be disqualified if the artwork, or progress photos of the artwork, is already been submitted to any publication or social media (including Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn, and the artists personal website).
- Winning submissions will become the exclusive property of Assyrian Cultural Foundation in exchange for the prize money and the winning art may be promoted by the organization in any medium.
- If artwork is selected as a finalist, the artist will be required to deliver the original painting to ACF for the final round of evaluations. ACF will reimburse expenses associated with shipment up to \$500. ACF shall not be liable for loss or damage caused by shipments.

#### **Disqualifications:**

Our goal is to promote and nurture our talented Assyrian artists. Therefore professional commitment and adhering to timeline is expected. The Assyrian Cultural Foundation reserves the right to disqualify any entry due to violations of rules or noncompliance with our policies. ACF reserves the right to resolve any disputes regarding interpretations of the rules, and to update or modify rules at anytime, without notice.

# **Judging Criteria**

The final suitability of the artwork for the 2023 Assyrian International Art Competition will be made by an independent Panel of judges selected. Judges will be asked to consider and score each piece individually. Artwork will be evaluated based on the following elements of artistic expression

#### **PRIZES**

1st Place—\$10,000

2nd Place—\$5,000

3rd Place—\$3,000
