2024 Policy Statement

The following policies apply to all participants in the ACF Tutoring Program at the Assyrian Cultural Foundation:

ACF Tutoring Program students are expected to adhere to all attendance policies for those classes for which they are registered. Under no circumstances should attendance in classes ever be considered optional. We expect at least 24-hour notice of an impending absence. Kindly take notice that more than three (3) excused absences during a course are grounds for dismissal. A single unexcused absence will constitute immediate dismissal. Please understand that we do this to be fair to all of our students, as well as to protect our time. Our teachers' schedules are extremely demanding, and they incur expenses to maintain the schedules they have set.

Student schedules are set by our Program Administrator. Though we do everything that we can to accommodate schedule requests, there may be situations in which availability prohibits us from honoring a request. Please be advised that student schedules are subject to change.

Students are expected to complete an assessment test before they start their sessions. The tutors will provide the students with the test.

Parents are required to be present during private lessons.

Lastly, our tutoring program reserves the right, and may give permission to appropriate staff and/or outside media, to photograph and record (video and audio) classes, programs, and participants at all our facilities and properties. Please be aware that these photos or recordings are for promotional purposes and maybe used in future print or electronic publications and media communications. By participating in our programs, you consent to the video or audio recording or taking of photographs for these purposes.

Regular attendance and commitment is expected. ACF Tutoring Program reserves the right to dismiss any student due to frequent absences, disciplinary problems, and/or parental noncompliance with our policies.
