Important Must Know Guidelines

Timeline for the event:

Deadline for Receiving Entries: November 1, 2024

Eligibility:

The competition is open to Assyrian artists from around the world aged 18 years or older.

ARTWORK CRITERIA

- Two-dimensional artwork in one of the following mediums:
 - o Painting (oil, acrylic, watercolor)
 - Drawings (colored pencil, ink, marker, pastel, charcoal, graphite)
 - o Collages (must be two-dimensional)
 - o Mixed Media (Use of more than two mediums listed above)
- No digital or graghic art. Art that is found to be constructed with AI will be disqualified.
- Must be a minimum of 5 sq/ft (24"x30") or 4645.15sq/cm (60.96x76.2) in size

HOW TO APPLY

Fill out the final page at the end of this document. This includes the brief (200 word maximum) "Artist Statement" explaining your art, your creative process and what the theme means to you.

Send the completed form, along with and three high resolution images to finearts@acf-us.org before midnight November 1st.

Assyrian Cultural Foundation may color correct your images in order to enhance the overall presentation, and may crop your images for formatting purposes for use in their slideshow presentations, other off-site slideshows, YouTube presentations, other Contemporary Art Gallery Online presentations; and for other areas of its website if your images are chosen.

Digital image files must meet the following specifications:

- Three high-resolution pictures (1080 x 1080 pixels)
- JPEG or PNG files only. Pictures taken from your smartphone are acceptable.
- Images must not be edited or altered in any way. Do not send images of your artwork which have been framed or contain watermarks.

RULES

- Participants are allowed submit one (1) piece.
- Participants must submit a new work of art made for the competition.
- Submissions after deadlines will not be considered for evaluation. Artists are not allowed to make edits to works that haeady been submitted to the competition. This includes adding additional details, varnish, or the framing/stretching of a piece. The work must be completed, in its entirety, by November 1st at midnight.
- Participants will be disqualified if the artwork, or progress photos of the artwork, is already been submitted to any publication or social media (including Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn, and the artists personal website)
- Entry must be original in concept, design, and execution, and must not violate U.S. copyright laws. Non-compliance to this rule will be a disqualification of your entry.
- Winning submissions will become the exclusive property of Assyrian Cultural Foundation in exchange for the prize money and the winning art may be promoted by the organization in any medium.
- If artwork is selected as a finalist, the artist will be required to deliver the original painting to ACF for the final round of evaluations. ACF will reimburse expenses associated with shipment up to \$500. ACF shall not be liable for loss or damage caused by shipments.

Disqualifications:

Our goal is to promote and nurture our talented Assyrian artists. Therefore professional commitment and adhering to timeline is expected. The Assyrian Cultural Foundation reserves the right to disqualify any entry due to violations of rules or noncompliance with our policies. ACF reserves the right to resolve any disputes regarding interpretations of the rules, and to update or modify rules at anytime, without notice.

Judging Criteria

The final suitability of the artwork for the 2024 Assyrian International Art Competition will be made by an independent Panel of judges selected. Judges will be asked to consider and score each piece individually. Artwork will be evaluated based on elements of artistic expression

2nd Place—\$5,000
